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TRANStoWORK Work based Learning in Architecture, **Engineering and Construction** (AEC) Industry: the TRANSition of young people to WORK





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OVERVIEW

TRANStoWork project aims at enhancing, reinforcing and structuring work-based learning (WBL) in vocational training courses for young people aged 18 to 35 (EQF level 4-5-6), particularly in those areas of production that show a gap in skills and a lack of propensity to change.

In order to do so, collaboration between those operating in the production process (the companies), the Vocational Training operators and the social partners - Entrepreneurship Associations and Labor WORKS - is needed to make it possible for





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work-based learning to become pervasive within the training path, using shared methods.

The production sector taken into consideration is the Construction sector in its most innovative sense: the Architecture, Engineering and Construction (AEC) Industry.

The 6 entities from 4 EU countries (Spain, Italy, Lituania and Romania) involved in this project, will achieve the following target audience:

- 80 youngpeople(aged 18 to 35)
- 80 Companies
- 16 trainers

- 2. Promote the training of tutors, coordinators and trainers involved in the WBL process.
- Develop innovative tools to support WBL in order to make it easy for the companies of the construction sector to understand the high added value of the WBL training methodology, trying to overcome barriers and to conceive the workplace as a privileged learning environment.

- 3) Assessment Report of Pilot Experience
- 4) Vocational qualifications upgrade in AEC Industry

TheTRANStoWORK Project provides also a Mobility Event for Trainers and 5 Multiplier Events during the 24 months.

OUTCOMES& ACTIVITIES

The Partnership will produce the following 4 Intellectual outputs, all of them aimed at improving the work-based learning in VETsystem (Construction sector):

 Setting up of work-based learning model in the vocational training activities
